

**How to become a member of Rentz Baptist Church**

There are three ways that you can unite with this church in membership.

**By Profession of Faith and Baptism**—If you wish to publicly proclaim your faith in Christ as your personal Savior and you are trusting Him to forgive your sins, then you may follow Jesus in baptism.

**By Letter**—If you are a member of another Baptist church, you may unite with Rentz Baptist Church upon promise of your membership being recommended by your prior church.

**By Statement**—If you have previously trusted Christ as your personal Savior and you have been Scripturally baptized, then you may unite with Rentz Baptist Church by statement. This should be done when it is not possible to receive you by letter.
